

Sample Bequest Language

The Foundation for Mohawk Valley Libraries, Inc. welcomes bequests to support public libraries and library services in Fulton, Montgomery, Schenectady and Schoharie counties in New York State. Bequests may be made for general support, for specific Foundation activities or to support specific public libraries.

The Foundation prefers unrestricted bequests. If a donor wishes to restrict a bequest to a specific purpose, please select from one of the following established Foundation funds:

- To support community engagement activities in public libraries
- To support early literacy programs in public libraries
- To support new technology in public libraries

Donors may also identify a specific established public library in any of the four counties to receive funding through a bequest. The Foundation has restricted funds established for each qualifying public library, designed so that principal is retained and net income is distributed annually to the designated library. If a bequest is for more than \$50,000, it may be used to establish a new named fund that is tailored to the donor's wishes.
