Boosting Early Literacy - Libraries provide reading and language experiences for children 1-18. Over 3,000 area children participate in the annual Summer Reading program.

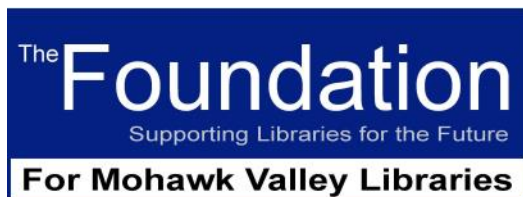
